All of the *Teaching Strategies GOLD*[®] objectives and dimensions selected for assessment in WaKIDS connect to Washington's State Learning Standards in the following subject areas: the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for English language arts and mathematics that were adopted in 2011 as Washington's State Learning Standards for those subjects, and the arts, health and fitness, science, social studies, and world languages. The skills and knowledge represented in the Washington State Learning Standards are representative of what all children should know and be able to do as they move forward through grades K–12. State assessments, such as WaKIDS, are designed to strategically measure most, but not all of these standards.

The *Teaching Strategies GOLD*[®] objectives and dimensions selected for WaKIDS are foundational skills necessary for children to be on the trajectory for meeting end-of-kindergarten State Learning Standards, including the college and career readiness CCSS expected at the end of kindergarten. However assessments, like *GOLD*[®], that are administered once at the beginning of the school year, provide a point-in-time demonstration of children's knowledge and skills; viewed alone, they provide a valuable but incomplete picture of a child's proficiency. In order to assure strong student learning over the course of the kindergarten year, the WaKIDS assessment tool should be supplemented by a robust instructional and assessment system at building and classroom levels that includes formative and interim assessment processes, including attention to individual student learning needs on a daily basis.

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¹¹ Based on teacher and principal feedback, and the recommendations of an ad hoc advisory group, the mathematics objectives and dimensions were adjusted for fall 2013 implementation to focus teachers' attention on concepts key to achieving the end-of-year math CCSS. Specifically, objective 21b, "understands shapes," was substituted for objective 23, "demonstrates knowledge of patterns." OSPI will continue to consider feedback from the field about the specific objectives and dimensions included in WaKIDS.
